#### Location

# MANORCON HAS MOVED!

After nearly 20 years at various locations around the Oadby Campus, this year we are moving to the Freeman's Common Campus near the centre of Leicester. This is the only location at Leicester University that currently provides us with the facilities we need – Oadby is no longer available.

All accommodation is in single, en-suite rooms located within the campus. Kitchen facilities are available in the accommodation blocks. The beds are small doubles (4' wide), so would potentially allow double occupancy, but we are unable to provide that this year. We intend to look into whether such an option can be provided for next year.

Full English breakfast is included.

# PARKING MUST BE BOOKED IN ADVANCE!

Parking is in the multi-storey at 11 Putney Road, LE2 7TF. Parking is £2.50 per day and should be booked online in advance using the following link:

Once booked, multiple entries and exits are possible to the car park as your car registration will be recognised by the system.

#### When you arrive....

The ManorCon Registration Desk is in the Freemen's Common Reception area, which is a short walk from the car park. This is where you collect your badge if you have pre-booked and where you pay any moneys owing. If you have not pre-booked, then we have a number of rooms available on the door.

If you have pre-booked a room, then you should have received a Room Chit by email (check your spam). Present your Room Chit, either electronically or a print-out, to receive your room key. Present your Room Chit at Freemen's Common Reception. If you didn't receive your Room Chit then don't panic; you can collect a copy from the Registration Desk when you arrive.

If you have any difficulties, then either ring the ManorCon mobile on 07391 046 410, or look for the Committee Member On Duty – look for the helium balloon.

We can now accept card transactions! This includes using an Apple or Android smartphone. Payments can also be made by cash or cheque.

Please try to arrange your transport so as not to arrive before ManorCon opens, which is at 2pm on Friday. If you are on public transport, and you will be arriving early because that is what the timetable says, or the drive is quicker than you think and you do end up arriving early, you will not be able to get into the gaming areas.

**PLEASE NOTE**: you **must** vacate your room and return your key by 9:30am on the day of your departure. All room keys should be returned to the ManorCon Registration Desk.

## **Gaming rooms**

Gaming will take place in The City Social Space, The City Reception Building and Mary Attenborough Accommodation including common room. Specific rooms are allocated for quiet gaming. All gaming rooms may be locked up for some period overnight; the exact details are not yet known.

#### Food and Drink

Breakfast, lunch and dinner will be served in the Freeman's Kitchen and Bar.

The bar should be open 2pm on Friday until 1am, noon on Saturday and Sunday until 1am, and noon to 2pm on Monday, but may close early if not doing much business. Note that due to the licensing laws you are not allowed to bring your own alcohol onto the site.

#### **Games Stall**

Meeple World have the sole right to sell first-hand games at ManorCon, and anybody else wanting to do so must speak to the committee first. A discount of at least 10% will be available on all purchases at the convention.
